Classes height order will be small to tall, Regular then select. *Check in will be any time prior to your first course of the day. General briefing, judge's briefing and walk through times listed in chart below.*

Please be at the start line, ready to run at the proper time! The judge (during briefing) and gate steward will let you know when that is. *Please email our trial Secretary Chrystal Thoms at cathoms@rogers.com or Sandra Orr at orrhowden17@rogers.com if you have any concerns.*

- Grounds open at 7:00 am.
- Measuring 7:30 – please remember to bring your own height sheet (attachment to email)
- General and Judges Briefing: 8:15m
- First dog on the line at 8:30am

This trial is OUTDOORS in the grass ring at back. You may crate out of your cars in the parking lot or set up tents on the grass leading to the ring or on the side of the parking lot by trees or in front of the rings but not too close to the ring.

There is an AAC trial going on at the front of the property in ring 1 please do not park up there but bring your cars to the back end of the large parking lot. No cars can go on the field past the orange barricades. It is still too soft to take that much weight.

We are taking day of trial entries until 8:00 please bring a cheque or correct cash for your entries

Ribbons

Bitches in Season are allowed to run at the end of their height division. Please bring your own mat for them to start on. Make sure you let the Trial Secretary know ASAP if you have a BIS

Food: there will be no food vendor on the site but Hwy 90 closer to the 400 has many fast options. We will have snacks and drinks for the volunteers in the volunteer tent.

Directions to the Red Barn Event Centre:

8464 County Road 27, Barrie, ON L4N 9C4

Please do not use address in GPS, use these GPS coordinates: lat 44.344860 long - 79.741025

From the 400: Take the Essa Road exit. Turn west on Essa (sign says you are going south). Turn right at Ardagh Road. Follow Ardagh to County Road 27. Go South on County Road 27. (aka Town Line Road) Property is on the west side of the road down a long driveway. There is a private residence at the front of the property. Look for our white flags at the end of the driveway.

From Hwy 27: When traveling North on CR 27 you must turn left shortly after passing through the town of Thornton. Look for the 20th Sideroad on your left and then the 10th Line on your right, that's your cue to slow down. Then you will see a small sign on your right that shows you must turn left to stay on CR 27. Turn left on CR 27 and continue north. After passing

Mapleview Dr. W. you will go down a big hill, the Red Barn flags are on your left at the bottom of that hill.

Please read the following rules:

In order to make everyone's visit a safe and enjoyable one, we have just a few rules:

- PLEASE drive slowly down the long laneway. Do not let your dogs out in the front of the property nor anywhere near the house as this is a private residence!
- Only park in the designated parking area. There will be signage.
- Dogs must be on leash at all times except when competing in the ring. No exceptions.
- Not all dogs love other dogs. Please keep your dog under control and out of other dogs' faces, even if your dog is not dog aggressive.
- Please pick up your dog's waste.
- Please clean up after yourself. There are waste containers for your trash.
- No smoking anywhere on the trial site.
- Please do your best to keep barking to a minimum.
- Be nice to our judges and ring crew. Remember if you want to be treated with respect, give others the same respect.

11) Last but not least, have fun! Agility is a team sport. So please leave prong collars and other correction gear at home. Remember we enter the ring as friends and leave the ring as friends!
