## NOTICE TO COMPETITORS

This test is being held under the Agility Association of Canada Inc. (AAC) Rules. Exhibitors through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of the AAC Rules and Regulations, to include but not limited to the following:

This test is open to all dogs being at least 18 months of age, including purebred and non-purebred, except bitches in season, dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness that may affect the dog's physical or mental performance, or dogs exhibiting signs of aggression towards people or other dogs. Everyone is responsible for the behaviour of their own dogs, please be respectful of everyone's dog and space. No leads, collars, food or toys or other training aids/devices shall be permitted on the course at any time. (this includes in your pockets).

Bitches in season may not compete. When a bitch comes into season after the entry has closed, a Vet's certificate certifying the bitch was in season within a 10-day period preceding the trials must reach the trial secretary on or before the start of the first trial. A full refund of entry fees will then be given.

Unfortunately, we can NOT refund entries after closing for any other reason. Anyone wishing to pull their entries after closing may upon request receive a 50% credit toward future Red Barn entry fees for another AAC trial held within twelve (12) months of this trial.

If the dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for such dismissal. (there will be no refund). Any handler who is found to abuse a dog will be disqualified. All competitors participate in the events at their own risk.

The General Agreement on the back of the entry form must be signed in order to comply with AAC's acceptance and acceptance to this trial.

The trial will be held indoors at the Red Barn Event Centre, Barrie, ON. ALL DOGS MUST BE ON LEASH AT ALL TIMES UNLESS COMPETING IN THE RING. DOGS MUST BE UNDER CONTROL AT ALL TIMES, EACH PERSON IS RESPONSIBLE TO ENSURE THEIR DOG IS BEHAVING CORRECTLY. if not, your dog will be asked to leave the venue. You must clean up after your dog, if found not to, future entries will be refused. Please no dogs in the café or washrooms.

#### **CLASS DESCRIPTION:**

AAC Starters Class: The starters class shall be for dogs not having earned the Agility Dog of Canada (ADC) title. A dog must achieve 3 clear starter rounds under 2 different judges to be awarded the ADC title.

AAC Advanced Class: The advanced class shall be for dogs having earned the Agility Dog of Canada (ADC) title, but that have not earned the Advanced Agility Dog of Canada (AADC). A dog must achieve 3 clear advance rounds under 2 different judges to be awarded the AADC title.

AAC Masters Class: The Master Class shall be for dogs having earned the Advanced Agility Dog of Canada (AADC) title. To be awarded the Master Agility Dog of Canada title by the AAC, a dog must achieve 3 clear Master rounds under 2 different judges.

AAC Steeplechase Class: The steeplechase class is open to all dogs. To be awarded the Steeplechase Dog of Canada title by AAC, a dog must achieve 10 clear rounds under 2 different judges.

AAC Veteran Class: Veteran class is for dogs 7 years of age and older or dogs 5 years of age and older who have been competing in the Special Agility Class for a minimum of 1 year.

AAC Special Class: Special class is open to all dogs. A dog entered in Special Classes may move to the Veteran Classes. A dog may no longer compete in the Starters, Advanced or Masters titling classes once entered at an official trial in any of the Veteran or Special agility classes. Dogs moving into Veterans & Specials from regular classes take their titles with them (i.e. they move laterally).

**GAMES:** Classes are now offered at 3 levels: Starters, Advance and Masters. Progression from one level to the next is as follows:

- Movement into Advance Games from Starters level games requires 2 qualifying scores under 2 different judges in the game.
- Movement into Masters games from Advanced level games requires 3 qualifying scores under 2 different judges in the game.

#### **PRIZES AND AWARDS:**

In each of the Starters, Advanced, Master's rounds and all games ribbons will be awarded 1st to 4th in each height division. A flat qualifying ribbon will be awarded to all dogs that achieve a qualifying score in any class. A complimentary new title rosette will be awarded for dogs earning a new title,

<u>MEASURING OF DOGS:</u> All competing dogs must now be registered with AAC. Dogs over 2 years old are measured by two Judges (or three if necessary). Once its official height is determined, that dog need not be measured again. If your dog does not already have its AAC number, please complete the "Dog ID Card Registration" form found on the AAC website & submit it to the AAC Trial Results Coordinator with your payment.

I certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. This entry is submitted for acceptance on the foregoing representation and General Agreement/Disclaimer. I agree to conduct myself (ourselves) in accordance with such Official Rules and Regulations (including all provisions applying to discipline) and to abide by any decisions made with them.



Please <u>do not</u> use address in GPS, use these GPS coordinates: lat 44.344860 long - 79.741025

<u>From the 400:</u> Take the Essa Road exit. Turn west on Essa (sign says Essa Road South). Turn right at Ardagh Road. Follow Ardagh to County Road 27. Go South on County Road 27.(aka Town Line Road) Property is on the west side of the road down a long driveway. There is a private residence at the front of the property.

**From Hwy 27:** When traveling North on CR 27 you must turn left shortly after passing through the town of Thorton. Look for the 20<sup>th</sup> Sideroad on your left and then the 10<sup>th</sup> Line on your right, that's your cue to slow down. Then you will see a small sign on your right that shows you must turn left to stay on CR 27. Turn left on CR 27 and continue north. After passing Mapleview Dr. W. you will go down a big hill, the Red Barn flags are on your left at the bottom of that hill.

- NO outside footwearin the Red Barn. Please change your shoes when you enter the Red Barn and store them on the shelving. Please dry off or clean off dog feet as well.
- 2. Please make sure you and your dog walk on the carpets to take off excess dirt/dust from shoes/paws before you enter the rubberized area
- 3. Speed limit is 10 km/hr on driveway AND parking lot. This is for safety reasons and NOT optional. You may be asked not to come back if you are asked more than once to slow down
- 4. Dogs must be exercised on the WEST side of the building or on south side of parking lot. Please pick up all dog waste. Fields to the north and south
- 5. Keep your eyes on your dog at all times to prevent dog to dog OR potty accidents! Use the crates in the entrance for short term if needed to change shoes or bring your stuff in.
- 6. No drinks other than water allowed on the rubber. If you are using bait/treats, please pick up anything you drop. No grooming allowed in the Red Barn.
- Smoking is not allowed in the Red Barn nor within 20 ft of the entrance. Cigarette butts must be taken with you or put in the sand buckets provided.
- 8. Do not drag <u>anything</u> on the rubber. Wheels must be taken out from under contacts when you are done moving them. Dog walks need rubber pieces under them once in place.
- 9. Report damaged equipment immediately. If you broke something please let us know so we can fix it. You may be asked to replace or pay for
- 10. Please clean up after you and your dogs. Pick up poop and empty/put clean water in bucket if you use it to mop. Clean up spray AFTER the potty accident is cleaned with paper towel and/or mop is called 'unine off' and can be found in each ring. Put poop and used paper towels in outdoor garbage.
- 11. Potty your dogs before entering the Red Barn. If there is an accident please let us know immediately so it gets cleaned up properly!
- 12. Two sided tape may be used sparingly for weave poles at trials. Green painter tape may be used to hold down gamble lines. Please remove all tape after use. Please do NOT use any other tape unless you have permission.
- 13. Please put your garbage in the garbage & recycle (separate paper from plastic) bins and do not leave dog treats lying around nor in your crate if you are a member.
- 14. If you are crating dogs in your vehicle please keep barking to a minimum as we need to keep our neighbours happy.
