General Information This trial is being held under the Agility Association of Canada Inc (AAC) rules and regulations. Exhibitors by submission of entry, acknowledge that they are aware of these Regulations. The trial will be held outdoors at the Red Barn Event Centre, Barrie, Ont. All dogs must be on leash at all times unless competing in the ring. Dogs must be under control at all times, each person is responsible to ensure their dog is behaving correctly, if not, you will be asked to leave the venue. You must clean up after your dog, if found not to, future entries will be refused. Please no dogs in the café or washrooms. **Please read the updated Covid19 washroom/building policy.**

Eligibility This trial's organizing committee reserves the right to refuse any entry and is in full charge of the trial. This trial is open to all dogs being at least 18 months of age, including purebred and non-purebred, except bitches in season, dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness that may affect the dog's physical or mental performance, or dogs exhibiting signs of aggression towards people or other dogs.

Refunds There shall be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date or in the event the dog is absent on the day of the trial. If the dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for such dismissal, there will be no refund. Any handler who is found to abuse a dog will be disqualified and dismissed. Full refunds will be given for withdrawals before the closing date. Full refunds for withdrawals of bitches in season or injured dogs with a Veterinarian's note received by the trial secretary prior to the trial. All competitors participate in the events at their own risk. The General Agreement beside the entry form must be signed in order to comply with AAC's acceptance and acceptance to this trial.

Ring Info This trial will be held outdoors on grass in 2 - 100 ft by 100 ft fenced grass rings. Agility Equipment will be chosen from those described in the AAC Rulebook. Rubberized contacts and E-timing will be used.

The person who signs this agreement represents that he/she ("I") is authorized to enter into this agreement. I certify that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner of the dog entered hereon. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I/we ("I") have read, and understand and will abide by the Official Rules and Regulations of the Agility Association of Canada, Inc. (AAC) in the effect at the time of this entry, and by any additional rules and regulations appearing in the Agility Trial Schedule for this event. I certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. This entry is submitted for acceptance on the foregoing representation and General Agreement/Disclaimer. I agree to conduct myself (ourselves) in accordance with such Official Rules and Regulations (including all provisions applying to discipline) and to abide by any decisions made with them. I agree that the organizations hosting this event (Red Barn Event Centre) has the right to refuse this entry for cause, which the organization shall deem to be sufficient. Volunteer Positions

Many workers make for shorter days. We ask that you help at our trials as they could not happen without help. Keep in mind that your safety is paramount.

Positions Available: **Scribe, Timer, Gate Steward, Ring Crew, Course Builder.** There will be no leash runner. Carry your leash in your pocket or drop it at the exit gate.

The Gate Steward may use a mic, if needed. Please pay attention, listen and stay well back

A blank **volunteer schedule** will be available at the trial for a volunteer to fill in for you.

COVID-19 Special Provisions

All competitors must wear face masks when walking the course.

Running Order:

Starter Courses to run first – **Advanced** Courses to run next, then **Master** Course to run last. The confirmation will give approximate start times for Advanced & Master courses. Please leave after you have helped set the course for the next level. Please do not arrive too early. Plan to crate in your car. Course maps will be available to photograph or as hard copy

Measuring: Only dogs without ONE measurement need to be measured for now. Handler must be masked while the dog is being measured. Temporary height cards will be used.

CLASS DESCRIPTION:

AAC Starters Class: The starters class shall be for dogs not having earned the Agility Dog of Canada (ADC) title. A dog must achieve 3 clear starter rounds under 2 different judges to be awarded the ADC title.

AAC Advanced Class: The advanced class shall be for dogs having earned the Agility Dog of Canada (ADC) title, but that have not earned the Advanced Agility Dog of Canada (AADC). A dog must achieve 3 clear advance rounds under 2 different judges to be awarded the AADC title.

AAC Masters Class: The Master Class shall be for dogs having earned the Advanced Agility Dog of Canada (AADC) title. To be awarded the Master Agility Dog of Canada title by the AAC, a dog must achieve 3 clear Master rounds under 2 different judges.

AAC Steeplechase Class: The steeplechase class is open to all dogs. To be awarded the Steeplechase Dog of Canada title by AAC, a dog must achieve 10 clear rounds under 2 different judges.

AAC Master Challenge Class: The Challenge Class shall be open to only dogs that are competing at the AAC Master Standard level. Five qualifying legs, under 2 different judges are required to be awarded the Master Challenge Dog of Canada title. After January 1st, 2011 a Master Standard leg will be earned if a run is clear and under judge's set time but not within 1.2 times of the fastest clean dog in your jump height.

AAC Veteran Class: Veteran class is for dogs 7 years of age and older or dogs 5 years of age and older who have been competing in the Special Agility Class for a minimum of 1 year.

AAC Special Class: Special class is open to all dogs. A dog entered in Special Classes may move to the Veteran Classes. A dog may no longer compete in the Starters, Advanced or Masters titling classes once entered at an official trial in any of the Veteran or Special agility classes. Dogs moving into Veterans & Specials from regular classes take their titles with them (i.e. they move laterally).

GAMES: Classes are now offered at 3 levels: Starters, Advance and Masters. Progression from one level to the next is as follows:

Movement into Advance Games from Starters level games requires 2 qualifying scores under 2 different judges in the game.

Movement into Masters games from Advanced level games requires 3 qualifying scores under 2 different judges in the game.

PRIZES AND AWARDS: In each of the Starters, Advanced, Master's rounds and all games ribbons will be awarded 1st to 4th in each height division. A flat qualifying ribbon will be awarded to all dogs that achieve a qualifying score in any class. New title rosette will be available for sale, for dogs earning a new title,

Warm Up Runs-when offered

The dog and handler will be allowed 75 seconds in the ring to follow their own route. Toys are permitted, as is food that must go directly into the dog's mouth and NOT be crumbly. The dog must be entered in the trial. Only 1 WarmUp run per dog.

From the 400: Take the Essa Road exit. Turn west on Essa (sign says Essa Road South). Turn right at Ardagh Road. Follow Ardagh to County Road 27. Go south on County Road 27. (aka Town Line Road) Property is on the west side of the road down a long driveway. There is a private residence at the front of the property.

From Hwy 27: When traveling north on CR 27 you must turn left shortly after passing through the town of Thorton. Look for the 20th Sideroad on your left and then the 10th Line on your right, that's your cue to slow down. Then you will see a small sign on your right that shows you must turn left to stay on CR 27. Turn left on CR 27 and continue north. After passing Maplevue Dr. W. you will go down a big hill, the Red Barn flags are on your left at the bottom of that hill.
