\*\* It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit, on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

If, because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of management, it is impossible to start or to complete this event, no refund of entry will be made.

CKC has a Non-Member Participation Fee of \$170.00 + HST. This fee only applies to dogs wholly owned by non-member residents of Canada and is not applicable to CKC members.

In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level. The fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non-member residents of Canada and is not applicable to CKC members. These events are open to mixed and unrecognized breeds. In order to compete, mixed and unrecognized breed dogs must have a Canine Companion Number (CCN) from the Canadian Kennel Club and must have a CKC-approved microchip. Mixed-breed dogs must be spayed or neutered. Unrecognized-breed dogs do not need to be spayed or neutered. A dog eligible for a CCN may not be entered as a listed dog. If a dog is not registered individually in the CKC studbook it may be entered as a listed dog per CKC rules for this designation, as of July 1, 2018; exhibitors must apply to the CKC for “Temporary competition number (TCN), before event closing date”.

As of January 1, 2020, as per CKC regulations if a dog is injured after entry has been submitted to the Trial Secretary, a veterinarian’s certificate, certifying the dog was injured before a 3-day period preceding the trial, must reach the Trial Secretary on or before the start of the trial. The club will refund the entry minus the TCN fee and a 30% administration fee.

Effective January 1, 1992, all dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an Event Registration Number (ERN). This ERN does not register a dog for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act, but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog’s foreign registration certificate with a cheque or VISA/MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder’s name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. Cost is \$64.00 plus taxes.

## RULES:

*To make everyone's visit a safe and enjoyable one, we have just a few rules*

- \*PLEASE drive slowly at the trial site.
- \*Please pick up after your dog so we can continue to use this location.
- \*No smoking anywhere on the trial site.
- \*Please do not walk past the areas marked with caution tape and respect the pylons.
- \*Dogs must always be on leash.
- \*No prong collars, choke chains, or e-collars on the trial precincts.
- \*Dogs must be on a flat collar, martingale collar, or flat harness only.
- \*Keep your dog under control and out of other dogs' faces. Nose-to-nose contact is not permitted.
- \*Please do your best to keep barking to a minimum.
- \*Garbage policy: If you bring it, you must take it home with you.
- \*Be kind to our judges and volunteers. If you want to be treated with respect, give others the same respect.

## ENTRY FEES:

*All fees payable in Canadian Funds*

*Day of trial entries will be accepted. Entries must be made at least one hour before the start of the trial.*

- **Entry Fee per dog per component Master, Excellent.....\$35.00**
  - **Entry Fee per dog per component Open, Novice.....\$30.00**
  - **Entry Fee per dog Instinct.....\$15.00**
  - **Entry Fee after closing date, when space permits (all levels).....\$43.00**
  - **TCN List fee (per dog, per trial).....\$11.30**
- (TCN List Fee is payable ONLY if no CKC registration number is available for the entered dog)*  
Each entry fee includes the CKC Recording Fee of \$5.00 + HST

**Potty Incidents:**

There will be a \$20 clean-up fee charged to owners whose dogs’ potty on equipment, search items, or anywhere indoors. This offsets the cost of cleanup to equipment (mats, barriers, etc.), or replacement of equipment that cannot be effectively cleaned.

**Entries:**

Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entries were made. Alterations, substitutions, or cancellations of any entry after the closing date is prohibited, except as noted in this premium list.

**Refunds**

There are NO CREDITS nor refunds for anyone wishing to pull their entries after the closing date. Lame dogs will be excused. Entry fees will be refunded with a 30% processing fee deducted, provided notice is given prior to or during roll call. If dog is not present for assessment, a note signed by a veterinarian will be required for any refund or credit consideration.

**Foreign Exhibitors**

Personal US cheques will be accepted in US funds, but due to fluctuating currency rates they cannot be discounted. Please do not mark personal foreign cheques “Payable” in Canadian Funds” or “At Par” as they will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Thank you.

**Bitches in Season**

Bitches in season are permitted to compete. They must be run at the end of the run order for each class and must wear clean, properly fitted panties. Please notify the trial secretary as soon as possible.

**Eligibility**

Scent participation is open to all purebred and mixed breed dogs at least 6 months of age that are individually registered with the CKC, or have an Event Registration Number (ERN) or a Temporary Competition Number (TCN), or a Performance Event Number (PEN) or are eligible for registration with the CKC and have a Miscellaneous Certificate Number (MCN) if it belongs to a CKC listed breed, or have a Canine Companion Number (CCN) if it’s a mixed breed.

**Entry Approval and Judging Schedule:**

Entry approval will be emailed from dogshow.ca after payment is received. A judging schedule will be sent approximately 5 days before the event date. PLEASE contact us prior to the event date if you have not received an emailed confirmation or judging schedule, and remember to check your junk mail folder.

Use the right lane to take exit 90 toward Mapleview Drive 550 m

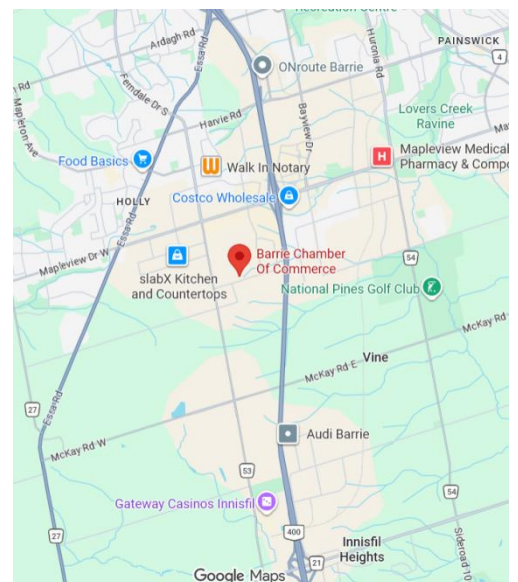
Use the 2nd from the right lane to turn right onto Mapleview Dr W 350 m

## CKC HEALTH REMINDERS:

**No dog may be brought onto the grounds or premises of an event if it:**

1. Is known to have distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease;
2. Has recovered from distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease within the last 30 days (prior to the event);
3. Has been housed within 30 days prior to the event on premises on which there existed distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease.
4. Clubs do have the right to remove a dog from the event premises and the exhibitor may be subject to disciplinary action if it is found that CKC rules have been contravened.
