PARKING and CRATING: Parking is available in the main parking lot as well as on east and west side of Red Barn. You may NOT park along the laneway under the trees. There is crating available in the Red Barn on a first come basis. The area on the SOUTH side of the ring is for quiet dogs only. If your dog barks or whines while you are helping in the ring please crate in EAST crating area outside of rubber area. Competitors may crate from their car but we will not have anyone calling out for dogs in the parking lot. You are responsible for being at the ring on time.

CHECK IN: At the registration desk you will be checking in and selecting your volunteering positions. Barb, the volunteer coordinator will be there to assist you. Your entry was dependent on your volunteering for at least 2 positions during the trial, without you we would be unable to run the trial.

COURSE MAPS They will be taped to the right of the breezeway on the red cage.

DOG MEASUREMENT: If your dog does not have one height measurement, it must be measured before

it can run a course. Dogs 2 years and over need 2 measurements by two different judges on a permanent height card. If your dog is under 2 you need to show his ID card. Measurement will be sent in by the Red Barn and AAC will send you a temporary height card.

WARM UP RUN: must be pre-registered and pre- paid. Only 1 Fun Run per dog. The dog and handler will be allowed 75 seconds in the ring to follow their own route. Toys are permitted. Food is permitted in a closed container. Dog must be entered in the trial.

LEASHES: We will have a leash runner.

RESULTS: Will be posted to the right of the breezeway on the red cage . The self serve ribbons will be at the front desk. If you do not wish to take them that is okay, we will be able to reuse them.

NEW TITLES: Congrats to those of you who achieved a new title and wish to get a new title ribbon. Please go to Barb at check in and purchase your new title ribbon for \$10 (please exact change only). Please send us a picture so we can post it on our social media 😊

HEALTH REMINDERS:

No dog may be brought onto the grounds or premises of an event if it:

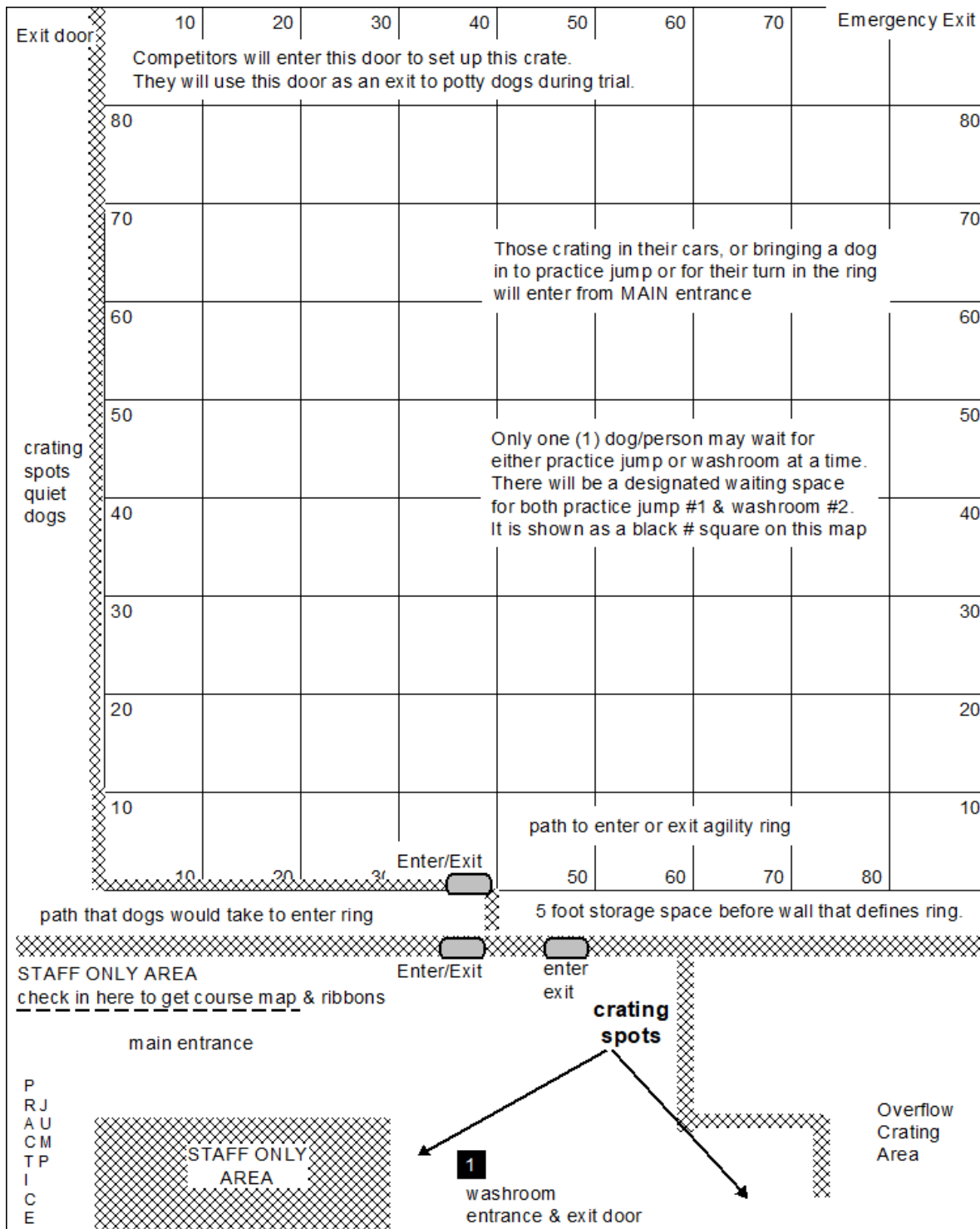
1. Is known to have distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease;
2. Has recovered from distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease within the last 30 days (prior to the event);
3. Has been housed within 30 days prior to the event on premises on which there existed distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease.

In order to make everyone's visit a safe and enjoyable one, we have just a few rules:

- PLEASE drive slowly down the long driveway. 10 km limit!
- There is a private residence at the front of the property. Do not walk your dogs down the driveway towards the residence as it upsets the dogs who live there.
- Only park in the designated parking area.
- Dogs must be on leash at all times, except when competing in the ring. No exceptions.
- Not all dogs love other dogs. Please keep your dog under control and out of other dogs' faces, even if your dog is friendly.
- Garbage policy at the Red Barn "IF YOU BRING IT PLEASE TAKE IT HOME WITH YOU" There will be a garbage can for the dog poop outside the door but that is all that can be put into it.
- No smoking anywhere on the trial site.
- Please do your best to keep barking to a minimum

Be nice to our judges and volunteers. Remember if you want to be treated with respect – give others the same respect. We have a zero tolerance for any abuse of dogs or humans. **You agreed to the Assumption of the Risk and Waiver of Liability on Agility Rocks** Agility is a team sport, so please leave prong collars and other correction gear at home. Remember we enter the ring as friends and leave the ring as friends.

CRATING: The East area (on concrete) of the crating area is for dogs who whine or bark only. The Red Barn is excited to say there has been some renovations recently. Our main

crating area has changed slightly, so those of you with dogs who are quiet please crate in the south area to ensure there is room for all who want to crate indoors. Competitors may crate from their car
