Dogs must be **15 months of age** to compete. For Exhibition Only runs are allowed with a silent toy.

Bitches in season are allowed to compete but must wear protective panties during their run. They must also be kept away from the ring areas when not competing and on lead, except when in the ring.

Dog's size division is determined by forearm measurement and there are diagrams to help determine this in the rulebook. https://www.caninehooperscanada.com/chc-rules

Entry Fees: \$20/run, 3 or more runs \$18/run, 6 or more runs \$15/run by the same handler

\$10/FEO runs

Day of trial entries will not be accepted

REFUNDS: There are NO CREDITS nor refunds for anyone wishing to pull their entries after the closing date. The only exception to this is an injured dog which requires a veterinarian note confirming this. In case of public health restrictions that prevent the event from occurring a full credit will be provided to your account to be used within one year. No refunds will be issued.

Classes: Beginner and Novice courses will have 15-20 obstacles. Hoopers uses mostly hoops. Parkour courses use a combination of hoops, barrels, tunnels and gates. TunGo uses barrels and tunnels.

Title Points: A clean run earns 10 points at that level. A Beginner title requires 100 points. Bonus pts are available on clean runs by the Handler remaining inside a Distance Handling Box (DHB)(5-20 additional points) or staying behind the Challenge Line (CL)(5-15 additional points). More details are in the Rulebook. Novice – 200 points in Novice level in order to earn title and progress to the Intermediate level. Attendance, Participation and/or Entry into this event confirms acceptance of the attached Waiver and all aspects of the CHC Rulebook.
